## LEAGUE DESCRIPTIONS FOR 2019 SPRING SEASON (Mid-April thru Mid-June)

Players are rostered in Softball based on school grade and in Baseball based on "League Age" as determined by player's age (in whole years) as of April 30, 2019.

### SOFTBALL

<b>8U</b> 5-8 yrs	Totally instructional league is <b>STRONGLY RECOMMENDED</b> to teach and reinforce fundamental skills of softball, ie. hitting, throwing, fielding and base running. Saturday afternoons at 2:00.
<b>10U</b> 9-10 yrs	Instructional league building on the fundamentals learned in Clinic. Two games per week at Ginn, Ambrose, Parkhurst.
<b>12U</b> 11-12	Advanced instruction with more competitive games. Two games per week at Ginn and Ambrose.
<b>14U</b> 13-14	More competitive while still instructional. Games are twice per week (avoiding conflicts with other sports), mostly on weekday evenings. At Ginn and Ambrose.

### BASEBALL

<b>CLINIC</b> 6 yrs	Totally instructional league is <b>STRONGLY RECOMMENDED</b> to teach basic skills (throw, hit, catch flies, field grounders, run bases) to small groups of boys and girls. Saturdays mornings at Nutile Field.
<b>ROOKIE</b> 7 yrs	Instructional league continuing the development of young players in basic skills via team clinics for half each session, then games for the remaining half. Saturday mornings and at Nutile. Coaches Pitch
<b>A</b> 8 yrs	Designed to be introduction to the sport. Continue to emphasize basic skills via team clinics for half each session, then games for remaining half. Saturday mornings & some Sunday early PMs at Nutile, McDonald, Mullen. Player Pitch
<b>AA</b> 9 yrs	Full uniforms using Majors rules. Players pitch. Games are weekdays at 5:45 and some Sunday afternoons at Nutile and Mullen.
<b>Major 60</b> 10-12 yrs	Full uniforms using Majors rules on 60 ft diamond. Players pitch. Games are weekdays at 5:45 and some Sunday afternoons at Nutile, Mullen and McDonald.
<b>Major 70</b> 11-12 yrs	Competitive league on 70 ft diamond where players are drafted onto teams based on tryouts held each fall. Full uniform. Games are weekday (and some Saturday) evenings and Sunday afternoons at Nutile Field.
<b>BABE RUTH PREP</b> 13 yrs	Introduction to rules and skills on full size (90ft) diamond. Combined league with other communities. Full uniform. Games are Saturdays AM, Sundays PM and some weekdays at 5:45.
<b>BABE RUTH</b> 14-15 yrs	More advanced combined league with other communities. Full uniform. Games are Saturdays AM, Sundays PM and some weekdays at 5:45.

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### DESCRIPTION OF VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

<b>COACH (Manager)</b>	Teaches skills and strategy, coordinates practices, manages team during games.
<b>ASSISTANT COACH</b>	Assists in all aspects of above, substitutes on occasions when manager absent.
<b>TEAM PARENT</b>	Coordinates team's administrative needs, e.g., tickets, pictures, uniforms distribution.
<b>CONCESSIONS</b>	Volunteers at concession stand at Nutile Field.
<b>FIELDS</b>	Assists in the maintenance of playing surfaces used in our program.
<b>FUND RAISING</b>	Under direction of Fund Raiser, solicits and coordinates with local business sponsors.
<b>SPONSOR</b>	Provides supplemental funds in return for name associated with a team.
<b>GENERAL VOL.</b>	Called on from time to time to do administrative tasks, help with some of the above.
